PRESCRIPTION UNDER THE ACTIVITIES LOCAL LAW 2024 ('Local Law')

1. In exercise of:
 - 1.1. an instrument of delegation from the Council (Register no CCL-2020-1) made pursuant to section 11(1) the *Local Government Act 2020* ('the Act')
 - 1.2. an instrument of sub-delegation 2024-22 dated 26 March 2024
 - 1.3. all other powers held by or delegated to me,and having taken into account the local law requirements of the Council pursuant to the *Local Government Act 2020*

THE COUNCIL PRESCRIBES THAT:

2. Subject to compliance with the Condition of Exemption detailed in this prescription, all persons are exempted throughout the whole of each year from the requirement to have a *permit* under clauses 6.1, 6.2, 6.9, 8.1, 8.3, 8.4, 8.5, 8.7 and 8.10 of the Local Law, where the activity for which a *permit* would otherwise have been required but for this prescription:
 - 2.1. is carried out with the prior written approval of Melbourne Arts Precinct Corporation (MAPC); and
 - 2.2. occurs within that part of the municipality of the Council shown within the bold lines on the attached map, and known as Federation Square.

Condition of Exemption

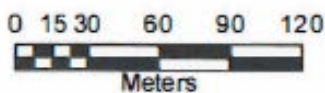
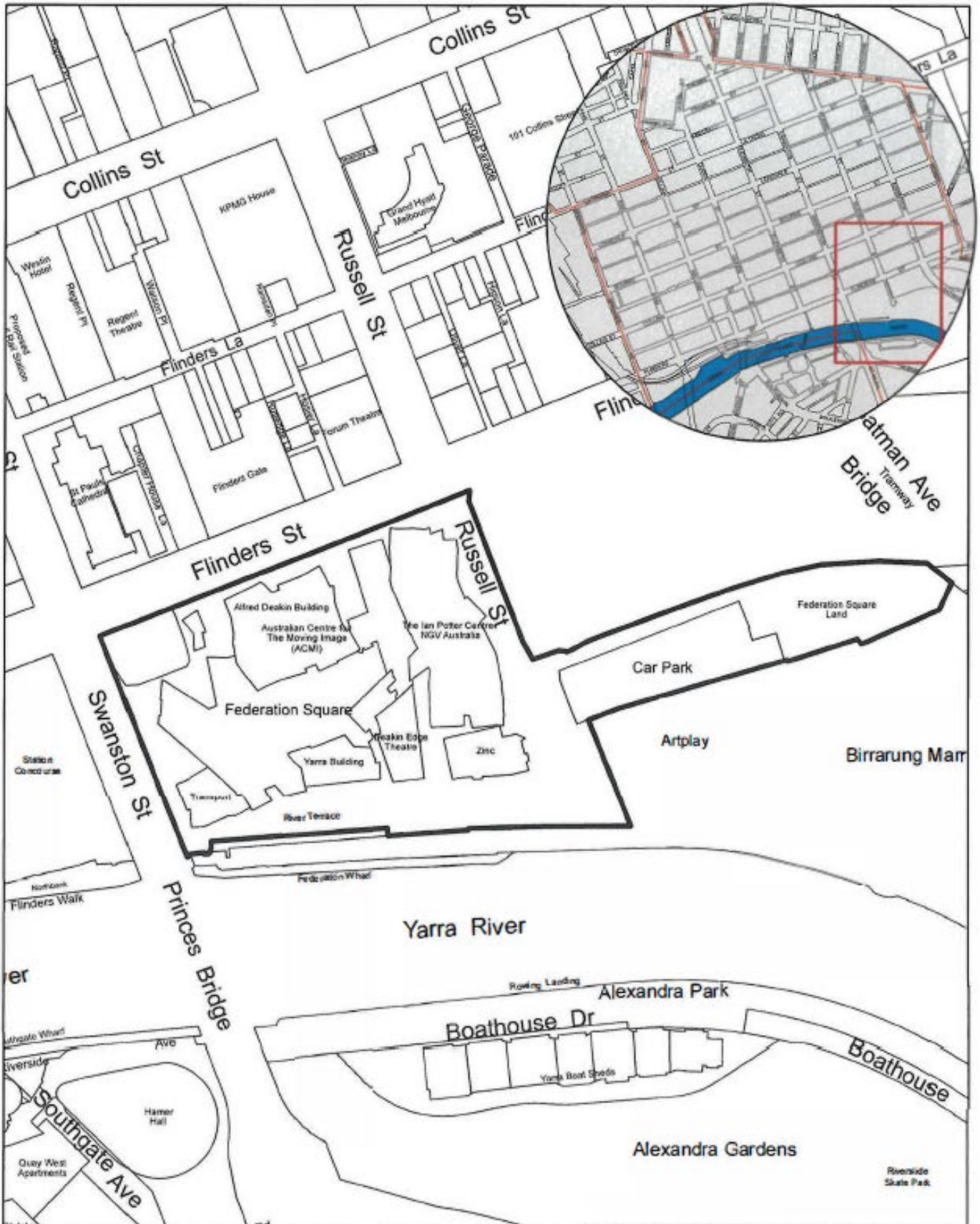
